

*From the Pastor's Desk***BE A WITNESS**

*"You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8)*

Father Ron Rolheiser is a priest of the Oblate Community. Presently he serves as President of the Oblate School of Theology in San Antonio, Texas. He wrote a challenging article entitled: "Following Jesus – according to the letter of the Spirit."

What makes a genuine disciple of Jesus? A true witness lives inside the Spirit of Jesus, the Holy Spirit. At first, this may sound abstract but it is far from being vague. St. Paul, in his Epistle to the Galatians, gives us a formula to determine who is Christian. He tells us we can live according to either "the spirit of the flesh or the Holy Spirit".

Father Rolheiser explains: "We live according to the spirit of the flesh when we live in anger, bitterness, judgment of our neighbor, and non-forgiveness. We live inside of the Holy Spirit when our lives are characterized by charity, joy, peace, patience, goodness, longsuffering, constancy, faith, gentleness and chastity."

There are many effective ways to be disciples, to be witnesses of our faith today. Among these are Email, Facebook and blogging, modern day boons to instant communication with anyone anywhere in the world. Sadly, in many cases, these instruments for good are twisted into instruments of evil. Many are those who "live in the spirit of the flesh" revealing themselves as mean spirited and angry people who will criticize, verbally attack, insult, and slander without any respect for others and without any thought of the destruction they inflict on a person's name and reputation. And sadly, some adult Catholics have joined some Catholic youth in these cowardly and irresponsible acts which are comparable to character assassination.

Frequent examination of our words and actions is of utmost importance in order "to live according the Holy Spirit". Anger, harsh judgments and prejudice have no place in the heart of Jesus' witness. What does it mean to be a witness of Christ today? St. Paul writes *"If we live by the Spirit, let us also walk by the Spirit. Let us have no self-conceit, no provoking of one another, no envy of one another."* (Galatians 5, 25) Imagine what St. Paul would have done with Email, Facebook and blogging?

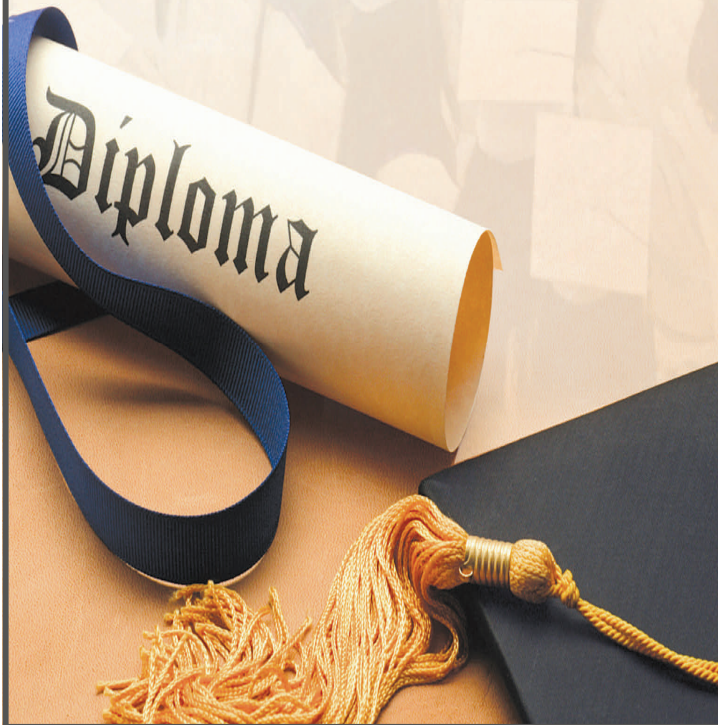
